In 2018 there had been a total of 101 single family residential plans approved. A bit behind last year but we are expecting an increase in multi-family developments as well as commercial. We are already ahead of 2018 in those developments.

The regularly scheduled meeting on March 14, 2019 was held at Fire Station #3, just one day following the Mother Nature directed relocation of our offices.
